

PTMC Championships 2010 Rules and Regulations

1. All participants must be fully paid up members of **PTMC** in **2010**.
2. Entries must be made under **PTMC** and **PTMC** must be shown on all documentation.
3. The competing vehicle must display two visible **PTMC** windscreen badges.
4. A sponsor's sticker may have to be displayed in accordance with MSA regulations.
5. All contenders **MUST** register with Championship Co-ordinators before points will be allocated and a fee of £5 will be imposed which will be donated to the Air Ambulance.
6. To be eligible for championship points, contenders **MUST** contact the Championship co-ordinators within 14 days of an events results being published. It is not the co-ordinators responsibility. (**No contact, No points**).
7. All contenders **MUST** marshal (not as an official) on one event and have their club Membership card signed by an official of the event they are marshalling on. (**No signature, no championship points**).
8. Club stewards for the championships will be Mr Baryan Joseph, Mr Brent Oatway and Mr Lyn Jenkins. The stewards may rule on points not covered in these regulations. The decision of the stewards will be final.
9. There will be championship categories for both **Drivers** and **Co-drivers**.
10. Qualifying events will be any **Asphalt, Forest Rallies** and **Road Rallies** run under a MSA permit, **Clubman's status** and **above**.
11. Championship points will be given for the **best 5 scored events from the best 7 points scoring events** with additional double bonus points on one round to be nominated prior to entering that particular rally.
12. If you start an event but **DID NOT FINISH (DNF)** you will be allocated 1 point. If you were to start and finish an event but you were the only **PTMC** Championship Contender (CC) doing the event, you would receive 6 points. If there were 2 Championship Contenders (CC) they would get 6 & 4 points, if 3 (CC) entered 6, 4, 2 points. At the higher scale, if 4 (CC) entered & finished they would Score 8,6,4,2 point (and so on). There will be additional points awarded if (CC) finished in top 3 of their respective class. 1st in class would get 3points, 2nd in class would get 2 points, and 3rd in class would get 1pt.
13. **PTMC** will provide awards to the highest 3 Championship Contenders in each category. Additional awards may be presented at the discretion of **PTMC's** General Committee. All awards will be presented at the **PTMC's** Annual Presentation Night, Dinner & Dance.
