Procedure on arrival in Llandovery

Please unload your trailer in the **Mart** car park at the rear of the Castle Hotel, do not block up the public car park.

Both the Noise Venue and Scrutineering venue are in a built up area, please drive carefully and quietly, we need the co-operation of the residents to continue using this area.

Follow arrows to the Noise Venue MR 160/761339, where you will be given your Rally Plates and Process Card, and then on to the Scrutineering venue.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES will Trailers, tow vehicles or support vehicles be allowed to park on the approach road to the noise/scrutineering venue. Infringement of this request will result in a refusal to start as per SR14.5 (C11.4) The competitor concerned is liable to be penalised in accordance with (R13(K)).

From scrutineering proceed back to the public car park at rear of the Castle Hotel and use the rear entrance of the Hotel **ONLY**, please park sensibly, we are all visitors.

If you have not registered your service vehicle, please complete form before arriving at documentation.

Time cards will be issued when your documentation is fully completed.

SERVICE INFORMATION

The Service area is situated at the New Quarry between map ref 160/ 868387 and 160/ 878397 and will be between both service controls.

The service area is large enough to accommodate the whole field providing crews are not selfish. No service vehicles are allowed in any other area.

All Service vehicles must be registered with the organisers, Service plates will be issued and must be fixed to front of the vehicle (**NO FIXED PLATE NO, ENTRY TO THE SERVICE AREA**).

Access to Epynt will only be via the Dual carriageway MR 160/861371, this will allow competitors to park their trailers in lay byes at map ref 160/862342

No trailers will be allowed in the Service area due to lack of room

A refreshment unit will be available in the Service Area

Competitors attention is drawn to the regulation regarding running of vehicles in the service area while the wheels are not in direct contact with the ground.

RECCE INFORMATION

A 'Recce' day will be held on the ranges on Saturday 13th March 2010, there will be charge of £10.00 per car.

Competitors are to register at Dixies MR 160/864364

Recce will commence at **10.30** am

Competition cars are **NOT** allowed to be used during Recce, this is an MSA instruction.

Vehicles will be required to display their High Visibility numbers on the front and rear of the vehicle, these will be stapled to card as you will need to use the same numbers on the event.

Do **NOT** exceed 35 mph when on MOD property.

At some point during the Recce convoys will meet other convoys travelling in the opposite direction, and the stage set up crews, please be aware, vigilant and patient at all times.

Do drive with care as set up crews will be in operation.

Follow convoy leader at all times.

DO NOT STOP OR HOLD BACK FOR ANY REASON.

Any crew deliberately holding back or stopping or deviating from planned schedules will be stopped from taking any further part in Recce, and escorted off the ranges, and reported to the Clerk of the Course.

In order for Recce to start on time please have vehicle registration forms completed before arrival.

All cars must be clear of the range by 15.00.

RECCE SCHEDULE

Stages will be traversed in the following order starting from Dixies

Marker Boards will be in place where the start & flying finish locations will be.

SS 1/2/3 Dixies – New Road.

SS 4/5/6 New Road – Dixies

REGISTRATION FORM
